- Buy revision guides for all students for maths, English and science.
Very good feedback from year 11 students and their parents.
A week of Core Curriculum time was devoted to using revision guides and workbooks.
- Monitor the behaviour of the PP and Non PP students using class charts.
Class charts has been very productive.
- Aim to reduce the fixed term exclusions for PP students.
Overall FTE rate in the school is down by over 25% year on year when we compare 2015/2016 to 2016/2017.
