Dear Parents / Carer,

I hope you and your families are safe and well.

On 30<sup>th</sup> December, Gavin Williamson (the Secretary of State for Education), announced that Y11 pupils will not return to school until 11<sup>th</sup> January due to the escalating Coronavirus situation. This means that from 4<sup>th</sup> January, your son's lessons will be provided by remote learning on Microsoft Teams. Please ensure your son logs in and completes his work. If he has difficulty logging in or you have queries about remote learning, please contact our Curriculum Deputy Head, Ms Carter: [h.carter@burngae.manchester.sch.uk](mailto:h.carter@burngae.manchester.sch.uk)

Your son should return to school on 11<sup>th</sup> January and his mock exams will now begin on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> January.

We are also now in Tier 4 restrictions – the rules state that you are able to meet with one other person outside of the home. Please ensure your son is not mixing in large groups – he is only allowed to meet with one friend.

If your son is eligible for Free School Meals, we will provide an Asda voucher for the week commencing 4<sup>th</sup> January. This will be sent to you via text or email next week.

The situation with Coronavirus is constantly changing and we will be in touch again if the situation changes before 11<sup>th</sup> January.

Remember: if any member of your family has symptoms of Coronavirus they must get a test and the household must isolate until the test result is known. If the test is positive, the household must isolate for 10 days.
