Updated information on the start of next term: 4th January 2021

Yesterday the Government made a last minute announcement that from 4th January, schools will only open to Y11 pupils, pupils classed as vulnerable or the children of key workers. We realise this news is very last minute but we were only informed by the Department of Education yesterday.

If you are a key worker and would like your son to attend school from 4th January, please email the school office by 24th December.

From 4th January, pupils in Y7, Y8, Y9 and Y10 will complete their learning remotely. All work and lessons will be available on Micro Soft Teams.
