Dear Parent / Carer,

We hope you are safe and well during the latest Coronavirus lockdown restrictions.

Remote Learning

Remote learning can feel difficult, as your son is not in a classroom. However, we are providing him with his daily lessons and he must engage with these on a daily basis.

The Government has stated that secondary school pupils should have 5 hours per day of remote learning. This does not mean that your son needs to sit at the computer or electronic device for 5 hours doing work, as this is not healthy and we do not encourage this much time at a screen.

Lessons

- Our teachers will either pre-record a lesson or deliver a lesson live via Microsoft Teams.
- If the lesson is pre-recorded, we have advised that the recording should be approximately 20 minutes in length with approximately 40 minutes of independent activity for your son to complete.
- If the lesson is live, we have advised that the lesson should be approximately 30 minutes in length with approximately 30 minutes of independent activity for your son to complete.

Expectations

We recognise that your son may be sharing a device with members of your family and cannot always attend a Burnage lesson at the allotted time on his timetable. However, we would ask that you ensure he completes the lesson at an alternative time during the day. He should complete 5 hours of learning per day.

Your son must ensure he is uploading work on Microsoft Teams for his teachers to provide feedback. He can also email it to his teachers. If your son is handwriting his work, he can take a photo of it using a smart phone and send it as a photograph to his teacher via email or MS Teams.

In order for your son to be as healthy as possible, both mentally and physically, time spent at the computer must be offset with exercise and time spent not looking at a screen.

All chat and comments made in MS Teams must remain polite, friendly and linked to work at all times, following the school behaviour policy as if pupils were in a school classroom. Please ensure your son uses an appropriate logo on his Microsoft Teams account.

If your son is feeling overwhelmed during lockdown, or he is in more need of support, please access the House area of MS Teams where support can be found. Students can also liaise directly with their House Leader through this method as well. In addition students can also email their House Leader directly for guidance and support should they need it.

Laptops

We have applied for more laptops for those pupils who do not have access to a computer; however, we do not know when they will be provided by the Government. We are also exploring other avenues to support those pupils with limited or no digital access. We will be in touch with those families as soon as we can.

Please remember that we must all support the Coronavirus rules and your son must not socialise with groups. He is allowed to meet one friend to exercise with outside of the home and they must maintain social distancing at all times.
