Dear Parent/Carer,

As you will be aware, since September 2020 we made a temporary change to our school day to support the additional COVID measures in place around social distancing. Our school day at present is:

- 9.15 start – 3.15 finish (lunch and break split over different times for different year groups)

Previously, our school day was:

- 8.15 start – 2.30 finish (one lunch and break time for all pupils)

Despite the challenges COVID has presented, we as a school have reflected on a number of benefits that our 'new' school day has allowed us:

- A later start time supports pupils' punctuality to school
- A later start time supports pupils' engagement in P1 lessons as pupils are more awake and ready to learn
- A later start time supports parents with primary school drop offs
- Split lunches create a calmer environment at break times and allows us to better supervise these non-contact times.
- Split lunches allow pupils better access to facilities
- Split lunches reduce queue times in the canteen

With this in mind, we are proposing that we make a more permanent change to our school day from September 2021.

With any decision like this, there will be some members of our community who this may not suit. For that reason, we will be consulting with all stakeholders including parents to get your feedback and consider any comments you have.

As part of this process, we have put together 3 options to consult on, which are included below.

Consultation will run until Monday 7th June. Responses will be considered throughout this period and a final decision will be communicated to staff, pupils and parents/carers the week beginning 14th June. If the proposals are agreed, it will allow a period of 11 weeks before the new arrangements come into operation.
