Dear Parent/Carer,

We wrote to you on the 18<sup>th</sup> May asking for your opinions regarding the timings of our school day from September 2021. During the consultation process we asked for feedback from parents, pupils and staff to ensure the final decision reflected the views of all our community. We are grateful for all the responses and feedback we received.

A summary of the feedback is below:

**Parent Feedback – 150 responses in total**

Option A: 8.30 – 2.30	50%
Option B: 8.40 – 2.40	8%
Option C: 8.50 – 2.50	41%
No Preference	1%

**Pupil Feedback – 84 responses in total**

Option A: 8.30 – 2.30	73%
Option B: 8.40 – 2.40	7%
Option C: 8.50 – 2.50	11%
No Preference	10%



### **Staff Feedback – 42 responses in total**

Option A: 8.30 – 2.30	62%
Option B: 8.40 – 2.40	10%
Option C: 8.50 – 2.50	26%
No Preference	2%

As the feedback shows, the majority of responses from each group preferred Option A.

As a school we have discussed this feedback along with all the comments made and feel that Option A is the most suitable for September 2021, with the following benefits:

- An 8.30 start time will give pupils more time to get to school compared with our traditional school day.
- A 2.30 finish time ensures there is plenty of time for extra-curricular activities and revision classes.
- An 8.30 start time and 2.30 finish time avoids clashing with other schools; reducing the amount of traffic outside of school.
- Option A avoids splitting the Period 4 lesson for KS3 lunch.

With any decision like this, there will be some members of our community who didn't choose this option and may be disappointed with the outcome. We hope you understand that we have come to this decision based on the views of the majority of our community and will work with us to make the new school day a success.
