National Information: Kids Eat Free Summer 2022

Some restaurants and cafes are supporting families by providing reduced or free meals over the summer holidays.

Asda Cafes are allowing children to eat for £1 between 25th July and 4th September, with no minimum spend for adults.

Morrison' s Cafes are allowing children up to the age of 16 to eat for free when an accompanying adult spends £4.99 on a meal (one adult per child).


